- High School Diploma or equivalent required.
- Must possess a valid driver's license in the State of Tennessee with "F" Endorsement.
- Must possess State of Tennessee Firefighter I, or above certification.
- Must possess and maintain a valid State of Tennessee Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic license.
- Must successfully complete within one (1) year of employment a Firefighter II certification issued by the State of TN Commission on Firefighting.
- Any equivalent combination of education and relevant experience may be considered.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

Under the general supervision of the Lieutenant, this position is responsible for performing entry level firefighting and providing paramedic level emergency medical care. This position entails combating, extinguishing and preventing fires; responding to and rendering aid during natural and manmade disasters; providing public education and training, and responding to and providing paramedic level treatment in medical emergencies. The position is designed to help the Town's Fire Department respond effectively to all emergencies.
