

Economic Impact

Dyersburg State adds \$67 million per year to area economy.*

For every \$1.00 of local revenues coming to Dyersburg State, there was \$3.10 of local business volume and from \$3.15 to \$3.47 of individual income generated, for a total return on investment of \$6.25 to \$6.57 on the local dollar.



•The **local business volume** generated by college expenditures during 2010-2015 was \$167 million, with \$139 million being due to non-local revenues. The annual business volume generated ranged from \$30.2 million to \$37.7 million.

•The combined five-year **direct economic impact** on the community represents more than \$337 million, or an average of \$67 million per year. Of this amount, \$284 million, or over \$57 million per year, is due to the infusion of "new"external/non-local revenues. This impact most likely would not have occurred without the presence of Dyersburg State in the area.

•Local full-time jobs created and sustained during 2010-2015 as a result of the College's presence totaled 11,922 jobs including Dyersburg State's own 1,177 jobs over that period. Of this total, 9,804 jobs were the result of non-local revenues. Annual full-time jobs generated ranged from 2,157 to 2,651 jobs.

• **Individual income** generated by College expenditures ranged from \$30.4 million to \$39.1 million per year. These expenditures totaled \$170 million during 2010-2015.
